Applications are invited for the full-time position of Web Developer for *CC Communications*. Position works in the Managed Services Department and is responsible for providing technical design and deployment of customer websites for viewing over all types of media devices, especially those owned or operated by CC Communications. Duties include but are not limited to: customers. Convert Photo Shop Design file into working mobile responsive website using HTML and CSS media queries, Bootstrap or other CSS grid frameworks. Creates and maintains HTML and CSS code and deploys website content

for customers. Deploys a website to a website host. Install server-side software instances and configure database connections. Manage domain's DNS settings (MX records and name servers). Backup and restores databases. Configure FTP accounts in dedicated server environment. Meets with customers, evaluates their website and/or other media requirements, and determines best methodology for meeting those requirements. Develops and executes plans and timelines based upon their evaluation of customer requirements. Successful candidate may be subject to a drug/alcohol test and a criminal background check.

### QUALIFICATIONS

- Knowledge with Adobe Create Suite tools (Photoshop, Dreamweaver).
