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Introduction to using your DVR



With a DVR, your TV world revolves around you; not the other way around!

Say Hello to Convenience and start enjoying the Control, Ease and Search Capability of your Digital Video Recorder!

What is DVR and what can I do with it?

Plenty! DVR stands for Digital Video Recorder and its functionality is just like a VCR but without the hassle of video tapes or troublesome timers. With a touch of a button, you can:

- **Record Your Favorite Shows** - Choose one episode or an entire season, record two shows at the same time (the show you are watching plus one more), build a library of recorded shows--all without videotapes or a VCR.
- **Watch Recorded Shows whenever you want** - You can even view one show or movie while recording another! Never miss another show again!
- **Pause live TV** - or fast-forward and rewind programming, so you can create your own instant replays.

Other benefits of the DVR include being able to view an instant replay, rewind your favorite scenes or play your show in slow motion!

PLEASE NOTE: You can store approximately 182 hours of standard definition programming, 46 hours of High-Definition (HD) programming, or a combination of those two.

How do I control my new DVR?

DVR functionality is available at the touch of a button on your remote. To begin, scheduling is as easy as going to the Guide, finding the program you wish to record and pressing the 'Record' button on the remote. If it is a single episode that you wish to record, one push of the button will record that episode. If you wish to record the series, simply push the 'Record' button twice. On the Guide screen, you will see a red dot for a single episode recording or a double red dot for a series recording, as depicted in the picture below. To edit the program or series recording, pressing "OK" on this screen will take you to the 'Edit' Menu, as shown in the bottom pictures.

To View My Recordings....

- Press the 'Menu' button on your Remote
- Select 'PVR'
- Select 'Recordings'



Here you will find the list of all program that you have recorded. From here, you can navigate to the program you wish to watch. You can sort this screen by 'Title', 'Date', 'Channel' or 'Viewed/Not Viewed.' The Program Title is followed by a number which indicates the number of episodes available for viewing. For example, looking at the screen below, you can see that there are six episodes of the show 'General Hospital' available. Once you select the program title, you will drop into the episodes and you can select the one you wish to view. Again, these can be sorted by the same options available at this screen.

Also from the PVR Menu....

- You are able to view programs that are scheduled to record by selecting the 'To Record' option. This will list all programs and times scheduled for recording, again with sorting options on the left of the screen.



- You can 'Schedule Priority' for programs where a recording conflict may exist. List the shows from highest priority to lowest priority. Also available in this screen is the ability to edit your program and series recordings. Just press the 'OK' button on the remote, on the highlighted program, to enter the menu.



Also from the PVR Menu....

- You can schedule a specific event to record, using a time and channel lookup rather than using the Guide.
- You can also view your recording history. This log tracks all programs recorded, playbacks and deleted content.



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Did you just get called away and you want to record the end of the program you are watching?

Just press the 'Record' button on the remote and watch for the red dot in the Info bar to pop up and you are set! The remainder of the current show will be recorded and available to you in your 'Recordings' menu.
